

Fiancé Visa Germany — Document Checklist

A tidy, printable checklist to help you prepare a complete German fiancé visa application.

Personal identification

- Valid passport (at least 2 blank pages, valid 6+ months beyond intended stay)
- 2 recent biometric passport photos (35 x 45 mm, white background)
- Copy of passport data page
- Birth certificate (PSA / original issuing authority), apostilled
- CENOMAR / Certificate of No Marriage or equivalent, apostilled

Relationship & marriage documents

- Certificate of No Impediment to Marry from your home country
- German fiancé(e)'s Ehefähigkeitszeugnis or equivalent
- Notice of intended marriage / appointment confirmation from German Standesamt
- Proof of relationship (photos, chat history, travel tickets, call logs)
- Signed statement / letter of intent to marry within 6 months of arrival

German language proof

- Goethe / telc / ÖSD A1 certificate (issued within the last 12 months)

Financial & accommodation proof from the German partner

- Verpflichtungserklärung (formal obligation letter) from the Ausländerbehörde
- Employment contract & 3 recent payslips of the German partner
- Meldebescheinigung (registration certificate) and rental contract

Application forms & fees

- Completed national visa (D-visa) application form, signed
- Declaration under §54 AufenthG (truthful information declaration)
- Visa fee: approx. €75 (payable at appointment, per embassy rules)
- Cover letter explaining your purpose of travel and timeline
